MEMORANDUM

TO: VIRGINIA HORSESHOE CRAB INDUSTRY

FROM: VIRGINIA MARINE RESOURCES COMMISSION

SUBJECT: CLOSURE OF THE 2019 HORSESHOE CRAB DREDGE FISHERY EFFECTIVE SUNSET, MAY 15, 2019.

Effective Sunset, Wednesday, May 15, 2019, the Virginia horseshoe crab commercial dredge gear fishery will close. Based upon landing reports from Virginia seafood buyers and horseshoe crab harvesters, it has been projected that Virginia will have harvested 100% of the horseshoe crab dredge gear quota allocated to be harvested by Virginia Horseshoe Crab Class A and Class B Permittees, by the above date and time.

Therefore, after Sunset, May 15, 2019, the possession or landing of any horseshoe crabs in Virginia by any gear type except trawl, pound net, or by hand shall be prohibited (Chapter 4 VAC 20-900-10 et seq.).
